

Jennings County 911 and Emergency
Management provide several methods to the
public to receive public safety alerts and
National Weather Service Watches and
Warnings. Watches and Warnings for
Tornados, Severe Thunderstorms, Flooding,
and other Severe Weather are sent out
automatically.

Occasionally other public safety related information may be posted such as road conditions, road closures, school closings, and other announcements.

There is *no fee* to sign up and text messaging rates as set by your cell phone plan may apply.

We recommend using several methods to stay informed of severe weather including TV/Radio, NOAA Weather Radio, and Outdoor Community Sirens. If you want to be informed there are plenty of methods available. It is also good to update your emergency plans. What follows are instructions to begin receiving emergency alerts from us via text message and/or email.

## Jennings County 911 on NIXLE

## (easiest and most recommended method)

- 1. Text **jce911** (no space) to phone number **888777**.
- 2. You will receive a welcome message from us indicating you have signed up correctly.
- 3. To stop this service at any time text the word **STOP** to **888777.**
