March 4, 2021


All Commissioners were present.

Matt said there needs to be a vote to make it a matter of record on allowing an employee in the Auditor's Office to work from home as the employee's husband is very sick and they are trying to keep her from being exposed to Covid. Shane made the motion to allow the employee to work from home as long as everything is documented and it works out for the Auditor's Office. Bob seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

He said the second item on the agenda was discussing an elected official moving to a county employee position and discussing their time eligibility as far as what carries over and what doesn't. It was discussed that should be a policy that addressed all employees not just one so he would like to recommend that they table the vote on that issue. Shane made the motion to table it. Bob seconded. Motion passed unanimously.


The retirement of an employee was next on the list, this was discussed at the Executive Session. They said they would like to pay the individual out in normal bi-weekly checks until their time is used up excluding sick time as they handbook specifies that sick time is not paid out in the event that the employee leaves. Bob was going to discuss this with the employee. They would be voting basically to allow the person to retire and they will receive normal bi-weekly checks, using up their time excluding sick pay. Bob made the motion to allow this. Shane seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
