

Jennings County Commissioner Meeting

April 23, 2020 6:30 PM

The meeting was held through ZOOM.

Matt Sporleder, Dave Lane, and Bob Willhite were present.

First on the agenda, Nicci Lucas, HR, gave an update on the Jennings County Employee Policies and Procedures Manual Amendment. This amendment states that the Family Medical Leave should be amended to read as follows: "While an employee is on leave, the County will continue the employee's health benefits during the leave period at the same level and under the same conditions as if the employee had continued to work." Bob Willhite made a motion to approve the amendment. Dave Lane seconded. Unanimous. County Attorney Ellie Bright stated that the amendment will need a first and second reading. The first reading was held at tonight's meeting. The Commissioners will have the second reading on May 14.

Next, Jim Reeves, Highway Department, requested signatures on five Community Crossing Matching Grant agreements. These agreements help fund current highway projects. Bob Willhite made a motion to sign the agreements. Dave Lane seconded. Unanimous. Jim then requested signatures on LPA Consulting Contract Supplemental with Janssen & Spaans Engineering. The supplemental represents an increase of \$139,825.00. Bob Willhite made a motion to sign the supplement. Dave Lane seconded. Unanimous.

John Post with the Recycle Center informed the Commissioners that recycling would start on Monday, April 27 on a limited basis. SEIRD will get with John to set up a plan on how recycling should run.

Commissioners will wait until next meeting to approve prior minutes.

Payroll and claims will be reviewed at the next in person meeting.

Commissioner President Matt Sporleder will sign off on claims to be ratified at the next in person meeting.
