Howard Malcomb opened the meeting by leading the pledge to the flag.

Sherri Williams addressed the Council and informed them of her upcoming surgery on December 14, 2017 and that she could be off 3 months. Ms. Williams went on to say that she will be working from home and will take calls and emails as she has a laptop that has been set up with all her work information.


Ms. Williams then addressed the Council concerning the health insurance coverage for employees for the upcoming year. She informed the council that the Commissioners had chosen option 6 for the county's plan. In choosing this plan the budget will fall short about \$70,000 and she just realized today that the county's paid life insurance comes out of that budget line item which is \$30,000; so the shortfall is \$100,000.

Reuben Cummings, financial advisor to the county, suggested taking the money from the EDIT fund. Auditor Vance informed the Council that there should be \$100,000 that will carry over from this year's budget that could take care of that amount.

Larry Maschino made a motion to use the EDIT monies for the \$100,000 insurance coverage; Josh Yeager I seconded the motion. Vote was unanimous; motion passed.

Josh Yeager made a motion to adjourn; Dave Woodall seconded the motion. Vote was unanimous; motion passed.
